Fist up was our MC for the evening, Bill Krupskas. Bill started off with the Paul Curry effect, Touch followed by Bob King's New Wave Prediction. Two very nice mental effects using decks of cards. Next up was Bob Weinowitz who demonstrated a nice prediction effect using a voodoo doll followed by a jumbo version of Danny Archer's Animental. Next was Werner Reich who is four score and ten and he performed an original creation which played like a memorized deck effect but he did not use a memorized deck. Well done!

Bill Krupskas was back with his presentation of Al Koran's Five Star Prediction. Steve Goldstein followed with Think of You by Jim Steinmeyer and another item based on the Amityville Horror house from right here on Long Island. Bob Lusthaus next demonstrated four effects. There were two packet tricks, Your Card, My Card and B'Wave. He followed that with a full deck trick for which he forgot the name and closed with a multi-deck trick, Trilogy.

And guess what, Bill Krupskas was back with Bob Cassidy's Chronologue. Steve Palamore was next and he predicted an entry in a telephone book (a what?) followed by a coloring duplication trick called Pen Prediction. Performance tip, you need to make sure that none of the audience participants suffer from color blindness!

Ed Hass the demonstrated an original creation he calls Shooting Dirty Pool. Really cool. Then Harry Mandel closed the show with a drawing duplication effect and a Lee Earle item called Copy Cat.

This was a really enjoyable show!
